Transfer Framework

- Certain spectrum licences have transferability and divisibility provisions
 - Various factors used in assessment of transfer and subordination of commercial mobile spectrum
 - Concentration levels, ability of existing and future competitors to provide services
 - Relative utility, substitutability of the spectrum and other bands in the area
 - Regional characteristics (population, density, other factors impacting spectrum capacity / congestion)
 - Timelines - 12 weeks
